MobileMed works harder during Hypothermia Season

Every winter, MobileMed ensures that the most vulnerable members of our community are supported. In addition to the health clinics we hold at homeless shelters four times per week, we also provide nurse case management at a third clinic during Hypothermia Season, the official designation for the period between November 1 and March 31, when those without permanent housing are most at risk.



CareFirst Grant Supports Expansion of Clinic Hours

MobileMed's East Montgomery Clinic is soon going to be open an extra half-day! A generous grant from CareFirst is allowing MobileMed to add Monday afternoon hours (from 1:00-5:00 pm) at our clinic on Briggs Chaney Road. We estimate that over the course of a year this will allow an additional 165 patients to receive primary care.
